# Long-term Capacity Development Program for Myanmar Private Sector (LCDP for Myanmar)

## 1. Objectives

- (1) To develop high level human resources in the private sector who can contribute to development and strengthening of the private sector in Myanmar.
- (2) To establish and maintain mid and long-term amicable relationships between Myanmar and Japan.

## 2. Scholarship

Following expenses will be covered.

(Tuition fees, Living allowance, Research support expenses, Medical care, etc.)

### 3. Duration

2 years for Master course

3 years for PhD course

## 4. Number of Participants

Around 20 (including Master and PhD)

## 5. Language to be used in this Program

English

## 6. Eligibility

Candidate applicants must satisfy all the following requirements:

- (1) Nationality: Must be Citizens of Myanmar
- (2) Age: Should be between the ages 22 and 39 as of 1st April, 2026.
- (3) Occupation:
  - 1) Have an experience for 2 years or more
  - 2) Capable to take long-term leave and return to the workplace after\_2 years for Master and 3 years for PhD studying in Japan.
  - 3) Have awareness of social responsibility, and willing to contribute to the development of private sector of Myanmar and network with Japan.
- (4) Study Field to Offer:
  - o Agriculture/Environment
  - o Economics
  - o Engineering/Information Technology
  - Management (MBA)
  - o Tourism
- (5) Academic Background:
  - For Master Program: Must hold a bachelor's degree
  - For PhD Program: Must hold a Master degree
- (6) English Proficiency: IELTS 6.5 or TOFEL PBT 550 or TOFEL iBT 80 or TOEIC 800
- (7) Study in Japan: Must enroll in a master's degree/Doctoral degree at a Japanese university from basically September 2026 (Depending on courses.)
- (8) Participation in MJC program: Those who have taken the MJC Business courses or be executives of the companies that have taken the MJC Business courses and activities before are eligible.
  - (Those who have taken related business management courses at UMFCCI are also eligible.)
- (9) Health Conditions: Must be in good mental and physical health to complete the program abroad.
- (10) Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment: Female candidates are encouraged to apply for the program. JICA/MJC makes a commitment to promote gender equality and women's empowerment, providing equal opportunity to all applicants regardless of sexual orientation and gender identity.
- (11) Others (Non-eligible conditions):
  - 1) Applicants those who are currently receiving (or are scheduled to receive) another scholarship shall NOT be eligible for selection.
  - 2) Applicants who are permanent residents of countries other than Myanmar shall <u>NOT</u> be eligible for selection
  - 3) Applicants who cannot physically come to Japan to carry out research activities to complete the program shall <u>NOT</u> be eligible for selection

## 7. Required document

All the applicants have to submit the following documents:

- 1) Official application form
- 2) Research Plan
- 3) Career plan after graduation
- 4) Graduation certificate\*
- 5) Academic transcript\*\*
- 6) Photocopy of certificate of English Test (IELTS/TOFEL/TOEIC/Duolingo)
- 7) A copy of passport and NRC\*\*\*
- 8) 2 ID photos (4cm x 3cm)
- 9) Health certificate (when the participant applied to the entrance examinations or within 6 months before arrival in Japan, whichever is later.)
- 10) For PhD candidate- Please attach Master Thesis in English and related papers (if any).
- \* Officially certified copies of the original
- \* Written in English or accompanied with official translation in English (Notarized version)
- \*\* The transcripts and grades of all academic years are required.
- \*\*\* The passport must be valid for at least one year from the time of application.

#### 8. Selection

Candidates must be selected through MJC's internal selection procedure (By MJC Selection Committee) and must pass the general entrance examination of the university they have applied to, including examinations to enter the applicants' desired master's/PhD degree.
